PRIVATE POOL RULES & REGULATIONS

2020

Your Board of Directors, in order to comply with Monroe County Department of Health Rules, and to insure the safety of all homeowners, has adopted the following:

- 1. Swimmers must sign in on the pool use log sheets.
- 2. Residents must be considerate and use common sense when using this private pool and pool area for themselves and their guests.
- 3. ABSOLUTELY NO SWIMMING UNLESS 2 OR MORE ADULTS ARE PRESENT.
- 4. Children/ minors must be accompanied by two parents/guardians. IN ALL CASES, A MINIMUM OF TWO ADULTS MUST BE PRESENT WHEN THE POOL IS IN USE.
- 5. Parents and/or caregivers are expected to supervise and maintain control over the activities of the children and/or guests.
- 6. Only greaseless type suntan lotion is permitted.
- 7. Only bathing suits are to be worn in the pool. Protective shirts are permitted. Hair accessories (pins, barrettes, etc.) must be removed before entering the pool.
- 8. Infants who are not toilet trained will not be allowed in the pool.
- 9. Pets are not allowed within the pool area.
- 10. Swimmers are encouraged to shower before entering the pool.
- 11. No one is allowed in the pool during electrical storms.
- 12. Please use the trash receptacles, replace chairs moved from their original place, and clean up when you leave.
- 13. Glass objects are not allowed in the pool area.
- 14. No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the pool area except for community parties approved by the Board.
- 15. Those with infectious conditions, open sores, bandages, cuts, or recent vaccination shall not be permitted in the pool.
- 16. The pool may not be used for private parties unless prior approval is obtained.
- 17. Residents who observe that the pool is being abused are encouraged to notify a board member.
- 18. POOL HOURS: 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. seven days a week.
- 19. Residents should be given preference regarding the use of the pool. Family members and guests can also use the pool. At all times they must be accompanied by an owner/resident of the community.
- 20. Use of toys, floats, facemasks, goggles, noodles, etc.is allowed in the pool with consideration of other swimmers. Any toy that is smaller than 3" in diameter cannot be used.
- 21. The pool will be open around Memorial Day weekend through mid-September.
- 22. The telephone is for emergency use only.
