

**RULES PROMULATED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
OF THE
BRISTOL VIEW HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC.**

Revised January, 2021

Pursuant to Section 5.11 of the By-Laws of the Bristol View Homeowners Association, Inc., the following rules have been adopted by the board of Directors:

1. Speed Limits

- A. Woodcliff Terrace is a private road shared with the residents of the Woodcliff terrace town homes. The speed limit on Woodcliff Terrace is posted at 15MPH.
- B. Bristol View Drive and the upper portion of Spruce Ridge are public dedicated roads. The New York State speed limit on roads not otherwise posted is 30 MPH. Due to the curviness of the roads and the fact that Lot Owners (“Owners”) of Terrace Homes (“Homes”) enjoy walking, please keep your speed on Bristol View Drive and Spruce Ridge well below official limit. You will notice caution and speed limit signs posted recommending the speed of no more than 15 MPH.

2. Parking

- A. On street parking of vehicles increases the risks to pedestrians and other vehicular traffic. Unless approved by the Bristol View Homeowners Association (“Association”), automobiles and other vehicles belonging to Owners of Homes and/or their guests are to be parked to the greatest extent possible in garages and/or driveways.
- B. As a courtesy to other Owners and all members of the Association, Owners expecting multiple guest vehicles for an event which is expected to last more than a few hours, are encouraged to request permission to house their neighbor’s driveways temporarily rather than parking in the eyebrows or on the street. In any case, no vehicles will be parked on the street overnight.
- C. Vehicles must not be parked in locations which will impede delivery of the mail, nor shall any other obstructions be placed near mailboxes.
- D. Vehicles must not be parked at any time in the truck and emergency vehicle turn-around areas at the midpoint of Spruce Ridge or at the ends of Bristol View Drive, Spruce Ridge and Woodcliff Terrace without the specific approval of the Board of Directors of the Association.

3. Penalties

All rules of the Association shall be enforced by giving the Owner an initial written warning and request to comply. Subsequent violations shall carry a penalty of up to \$100 per day or ½ of the monthly assessment per day, whichever is larger. Such amounts will become a lien if not paid, in the same manner of maintenance assessments.

4. Advertisements

Signs advertising a business are not permitted. Also not permitted are political signs, flags, and/or banners.
